

## **QUICK STATS**

- 29% of schools DID force students through SCI portal
- 21% of schools closed the portal before September
   5% of schools still have portal open
- 53% of schools are allowing mid-semester opt back in
- 80% of schools have a "Membership Ancillary Fee"

## COMPARITIVE DATA Forced Through Portal

When Forced 100% of students completed process When NOT Forced, 17.7% of students completed process

## COMPARITIVE DATA Membership Fee

8 Schools with Membership Fee Data

46.4% opt-out when forced through portal

VS. 7% when not forced

University opt-out 14% vs. College out-out 13.8%



### COMPARITIVE DATA Clubs Fee

9 Schools with Club Fee Data

35.5% opt-out when forced through portal

VS. 9.9% when not forced

University opt-out 13% vs. College out-out 14%

Closed portal early 16% opt-out

vs. 12% when closing Day10



### COMPARITIVE DATA Events Fee

6 Schools with Event Fee Data

#### 41.5% opt-out when forced through portal

VS. 12.3% when not forced

University opt-out 18.1% vs. College out-out 17.8%

## DATA CONCLUSIONS

- No noticable difference between College & University Opt-Outs
- Forcing through portal caused at least a 3:1 opt-out rate vs. no force
- Not many matching sets of fees between schools

9 Schools allowing, 10 Schools not

### WHAT WAS YOUR OPT-OUT RATE?

At Niagara, breaking into 3 sections:

Of those who exercised their right to choose

Those who chose plus those in by "default"

How whole are we as an organization financially

#### WHAT WAS YOUR OPT-OUT RATE?

- 57%-72% opt-out rate depending on which fee
- 8,500 students who didn't choose and are in by default (pay 100% of fees)
  - Take previous number and add in "Admin Fees" and "Essential Fees" – we are 93% financially whole at NCSAC
